Page 84 Sec. 11523 add between line 12 and 13:

If the applicant is a Municipality, Municipalities or Authority of Municipalities and the owner, owners pledge the full faith and credit of those participating municipalities by board action, the financial assurance required will be half the costs outlined for any composting, waste, material management or recovery facility. The full faith and credit pledge cannot be revoked until the applicant provides assurance that meets the full costs outlined for financial assurance for that particular operation.

Unlike private individuals or corporations, municipalities do not “disappear” and can be held accountable for their obligations. They also are responsible to the public for use of public funds and tying up large sums of cash when they have otherwise obligated themselves can be seen as doubling the obligation.

Page 91 Sec. 11523a Add to line 12:

If the applicant is a Municipality, Municipalities or Authority of Municipalities and the owner, owners pledge the full faith and credit of those participating municipalities by board action, the financial assurance required will be half the costs outlined in section 11523a. The full faith and credit pledge cannot be revoked until the applicant provides assurance that meets the full costs outlined for financial assurance in Section 11523a.

Page 111 Sec. 11527 add into line 5:

Licensed under this part and abide by all solid waste flow control or waste ordinance pertaining to waste movement and handling (see sec. 11531 (2) and shall use only.....

This just strengthens municipal ordinance's and flow control use to fund and maintain public investment.
